10 (a) Guidelines.--The Department of Health shall adopt
11 mandatory, evidence-based guidelines for prescribing abuse-
12 deterrent prescription opioids. The guidelines shall be
13 published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

14 (b) Educational materials.--The Department of Health shall
15 develop educational materials to explain the risks associated
16 with all opioids notwithstanding their abuse-deterrent labeling.
17 Prescribers shall distribute these materials with every opioid
18 prescription regardless of whether the opioid being prescribed
19 has abuse-deterrent properties.
