Amend Bill, page 2, lines 11 through 20, by striking out "a\_ 1 student who participates in vocational" in line 11 and all of 2 3 lines 12 through 20 and inserting a CTE Concentrator shall be deemed proficient provided that 4 5 the CTE Concentrator shall meet all of the following 6 requirements: 7 (1) completes locally established grade-based requirements 8 for academic content areas associated with each Keystone Exam on which the CTE Concentrator did not achieve proficiency. For the 9 purposes of this paragraph, completion of grade-based 10 requirements in any science and technology and environment and 11 ecology course shall satisfy the requirements for the academic\_ 12 13 content area associated with the Keystone Exam in biology; and (2) completes one of the following: 14 15 (i) attains an industry-based competency certification related to the CTE Concentrator's program of study; or 16 (ii) demonstrates a high likelihood of success on an 17 18 approved industry-based competency assessment or readiness for continued meaningful engagement in the CTE Concentrator's 19 program of study as demonstrated by performance on benchmark 20 21 assessments, course grades and other factors consistent with the 22 CTE Concentrator's goals and career plan. (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases 23 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless 24 the context clearly indicates otherwise: 25 "Approved industry-based competency assessment." A NOCTI 26 27 exam, NIMS assessment or other industry-based competency assessment identified by the Secretary of Education and approved 28 by the State Board of Education. 29 "CTE Concentrator." A student who, by the end of a reporting 30 year, will be reported as successfully completing at least 50 31 32 percent of the minimum technical instructional hours required under 22 Pa. Code Ch. 339 (relating to vocational education). 33 "NIMS assessment." An assessment based on the National 34 35 Institute for Metalworking Skills standards. "NOCTI exam." A National Occupational Competency Testing 36 37 Institute exam.
