20 "Constitutionally protected communication." Any good faith  
21 communication in furtherance of a right to petition or a right  
22 to free speech, which right is exercised in connection with an  
23 issue of public concern or social significance under the  
24 following circumstances:

25 (1) any written, oral, audio, visual or electronic  
26 statement or writing in connection with an issue under  
27 consideration or review by a legislative, executive,  
28 judicial, administrative or other governmental body or in  
29 another governmental or official proceeding;

30 (2) any written, oral, audio, visual or electronic  
31 statement or writing that is reasonably likely to encourage  
32 consideration or review of an issue by a legislative,  
33 executive, judicial, administrative or other governmental  
34 body or in another governmental or official proceeding;

35 (3) any written, oral, audio, visual or electronic  
36 statement or writing reasonably likely to enlist public  
37 participation in an effort to effect consideration of an  
38 issue by a legislative, executive, judicial, administrative  
39 or other governmental body or in another governmental or

1 official proceeding; or  
2 (4) any written, oral, audio, visual or electronic  
3 statement or writing that falls within the protection of the  
4 right to petition government or the right to free speech  
5 under the Constitution of the United States or the  
6 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
