16 (a) The department shall evaluate the efficacy and cost
17 effectiveness of software programs designed to identify and
18 prevent fraudulent, incorrect and duplicative payments within
19 medical assistance, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families and
20 the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. The following
21 apply:

22 (1) No later than September 30, 2017, the department shall
23 publish a request for information regarding the use of software
24 programs under this subsection and requesting prospective
25 participants in an efficiency evaluation. The request for
26 information shall include the requirement that the savings to
27 the Commonwealth from the use of the software program exceed the

1 cost of implementing and maintaining the software program. The
2 request for information shall be an informal document and may
3 not be construed to be a request for proposal or an invitation
4 to bid.

5 (2) (i) Subject to subclause (ii), no later than December
6 31, 2017, the department shall select no fewer than three
7 prospective participants that have responded to the request for
8 information under clause (1) to participate voluntarily in an
9 efficiency evaluation. The department shall provide participants
10 selected under this subclause with a test data set of claim,
11 payment and other information relating to medical assistance,
12 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families and the Supplemental
13 Nutrition Assistance Program. The department may require the
14 participant to agree to any relevant confidentiality
15 requirements or redact or otherwise anonymize the information as
16 necessary to comply with law.

17 (ii) The department may not be required to conduct the
18 efficiency evaluation if the responses to the request for
19 information under clause (1) do not demonstrate that the savings
20 to the Commonwealth from the use of the software program exceed
21 the cost of implementing and maintaining the software program.

22 (3) No later than February 15, 2018, the participants
23 selected under clause (2)(i) shall provide to the department a
24 report identifying potentially fraudulent, incorrect and
25 duplicative payments within the data set. A participant may make
26 a recommendation to the department on ways that the department
27 could have avoided making the payment and any methods available
28 for recovering money relating to the payment.

29 (b) No later than March 15, 2018, the department shall issue
30 a report with respect to the information obtained from the
31 participants' performance in the efficiency evaluation and any
32 related recommendations. The report may include a comparison of
33 the performance of the department's programs to identify and
34 prevent fraudulent, incorrect and duplicative payments on the
35 same data set. The report shall not include transaction-level
36 data and may not include any identifying information relating to
37 the payments. The report shall be issued to the chairperson and
38 the minority chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the
39 Senate, the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Health
40 and Human Services Committee of the Senate, the chairperson and
41 minority chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the
42 House of Representatives and the chairperson and minority
43 chairperson of the Health Committee of the House of
44 Representatives.

3 (a) Before submitting to the General Assembly a supplemental
4 appropriation request for the medical assistance capitation and
5 fee-for-service General Fund appropriations for fiscal year
6 2017-2018, the department shall either request a waiver or
7 submit a State plan amendment from the appropriate Federal
8 agency for approval. The waiver request or the State plan
9 amendment shall request additional Federal financial
10 participation, reduce expenditures for the medical assistance
11 program or provide program efficiencies.

12 (b) If the department submits a waiver request or State plan
13 amendment meeting the requirements of subsection (a) after the
14 effective date of this section, the department is not required
15 to submit an additional waiver request or a State plan amendment
16 prior to submitting a supplemental appropriation request.

17 (c) The department is not required to submit a waiver
18 request or a State plan amendment under this section if there is
19 a reduction in Federal funding during the State fiscal year
20 2017-2018.
