- (1) Twelve and one-half percent (12.5%) shall be deposited 26
- 27 in a restricted account within the General Fund. The money in

- the restricted account is hereby appropriated on a continuing basis to the Department of Human Services for training of mandated reporters of child abuse and child abuse related costs.
- (2) Thirty-seven and one-half percent (37.5%) shall be deposited in a restricted account within the General Fund. The money in the restricted account is hereby appropriated on a continuing basis to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency for grants for child advocacy centers and multidisciplinary investigative teams.
- (3) Twenty-five percent (25%) shall be deposited in a restricted account within the General Fund. The money in the restricted account is hereby appropriated on a continuing basis to the department for the sole purpose of costs associated with issuing certified copies of birth records. Acceptable uses of these funds are limited to the salary, benefits and training costs for an employee in the Division of Vital Records actively involved in the issuance of certified copies of birth records.
- (4) If a local registrar is involved in the issuance of a certified copy of a birth record, an amount equal to twenty percent (20%) of the fee collected for the certified copy shall be transferred by the department to the local registrar or, if collected by the local registrar, retained by the local registrar.
 - (5) The remainder shall be deposited in the General Fund.
- (b) Funding under subsection (a) (2) and (3) may not be used 25 to supplant Federal, State or local funds otherwise available 26 for child advocacy centers and multidisciplinary investigative 27
- 28 teams.
