

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 97

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 5, by inserting after "thereto,"  
2 in pupils and attendance, providing for transfer of attendance  
3 records to another school entity or nonpublic school;

4 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 14 through 16, by striking out all  
5 of said lines and inserting

6 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  
7 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a  
8 section to read:

9 Section 1313.2. Transfer of Attendance Records to Another  
10 School Entity or Nonpublic School.--(a) (i) Whenever a student  
11 transfers to another school entity or nonpublic school within  
12 this Commonwealth, a certified copy of the student's attendance  
13 record shall be transmitted to the school entity or nonpublic  
14 school to which the student has transferred.

15 (ii) The school entity or nonpublic school to which the  
16 student has transferred shall request the attendance record.

17 (iii) The sending school entity or nonpublic school shall  
18 have ten (10) days from the receipt of the request to provide a  
19 certified copy of the student's attendance record.

20 (b) In the case of a student transferring during the course  
21 of a school term, the student's unexcused absences shall be  
22 included in the student's attendance record at the school entity  
23 or nonpublic school to which the student has transferred for  
24 that school term.

25 (c) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"  
26 means a public school district, charter school, cyber charter  
27 school, regional charter school, intermediate unit or area  
28 vocational-technical school.
