

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 645

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1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 10, by inserting after "penalties,"
2 in realty transfer tax, further providing for excluded
3 transactions; and,

4 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 15 through 17, by striking out all
5 of said lines and inserting

6 Section 1. Section 1102-C.3 of the act of March 4, 1971
7 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended
8 by adding a paragraph to read:

9 Section 1102-C.3. Excluded Transactions.--The tax imposed by
10 section 1102-C shall not be imposed upon:

11 * * *

12 (25) Beginning on or after December 31, 2015, a transfer of
13 real estate by a housing authority created under the act of May
14 28, 1937 (P.L.955, No.265), referred to as the Housing
15 Authorities Law, to a nonprofit organization which is utilizing
16 the real estate for the purpose of Rental Assistance
17 Demonstration administered by the United States Department of
18 Housing and Urban Development under the Consolidated and Further
19 Continuing Appropriations Act, 2012 (Public Law 112-55, 125
20 Stat. 552).

21 Section 2. Sections 1904-A(c) and 1905-A of the act are

27 Section 4. The addition of section 1102-C.3(25) of the act
28 shall apply to a county of the fifth class with a population of
29 between 115,000 and 118,000 in the 2010 Federal Decennial Census
30 which filed an appeal with the Board of Finance and Review after
31 December 31, 2015.

3 Amend Bill, page 4, lines 10 and 11, by striking out "JULY
4 1," in line 10 and all of line 11 and inserting

5 as follows:

6 (1) This section shall take effect immediately.

7 (2) Section 4 of this act and the addition of section
8 1102-C.3(25) of the act shall take effect in 60 days.

9 (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect July 1,
10 2019.
