12 (a) General rule.--[A]
13 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), a person 18
14 years of age or older who is convicted in any court of this
15 Commonwealth of a violation of section 13(a)(14) or (30) of
16 the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The
17 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, shall,
18 if the delivery or possession with intent to deliver of the
19 controlled substance occurred within 1,000 feet of the real
20 property on which is located a public, private or parochial
21 school or a college or university or within 250 feet of the
22 real property on which is located a recreation center or
23 playground or on a school bus, be sentenced to a minimum
24 sentence of at least [two years] one year of total
25 confinement, notwithstanding any other provision of this
26 title, The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic
27 Act or other statute to the contrary. The maximum term of
28 imprisonment shall be [four] two years for any offense:
29 [(1)] (i) subject to this section; and
30 [(2)] (ii) for which The Controlled Substance, Drug,
31 Device and Cosmetic Act provides for a maximum term of

1 imprisonment of less than [four] two years.

2 (2) With respect to a college or university, the
3 provisions of paragraph (1) shall not apply to a violation if
4 the controlled substance is marihuana or hashish.

5 (3) If the sentencing court finds that the delivery or
6 possession with intent to deliver was to an individual under
7 18 years of age, then this section shall not be applicable
8 and the offense shall be subject to section 6314 (relating to
9 sentencing and penalties for trafficking drugs to minors).
