1 Amend Bill, page 8, by inserting between lines 29 and 30

2 Section 11. Collection of information and reports.

3 (a) Report.--Each agency shall gather and study the impact
4 of implementing this act and shall report, at least annually, to
5 the Governor and the General Assembly, as to:

6 (1) The cost of implementing this act. The cost shall
7 include:

8 (i) Resources necessary to implement policies,
9 procedures and implementation plans.

10 (ii) Changes or additions to paper forms.

11 (iii) Changes or additions to existing electronic
12 systems.

13 (iv) Time required by the agency to comply with this
14 act per application or reapplication.

15 (v) Personnel needed by the agency to comply with
16 this act.

17 (vi) Resources related to the storage and retrieval
18 of affidavits required under section 3.

19 (vii) Charges to verify the immigration status of
20 each noncitizen applicant as required under section 4(a).

21 (viii) Charges to implement, including all training
22 costs, the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements
23 (SAVE) Program, or its successor, as required under
24 section 4(a).

25 (2) The number of applications and renewals of
26 applications for public benefits from United States citizens
27 or individuals lawfully present in the United States pursuant
28 to Federal law that were withdrawn or denied because the
29 person lacked the documents required under section 3.

30 (3) The cost of compiling and providing the documents
31 required under section 3 by individuals, businesses and
32 organizations in the public and private sectors.

33 (b) Monitoring of SAVE program.--An agency that administers
34 public benefits shall monitor the SAVE Program, or its
35 successor, for verification errors and delays and shall provide
36 an annual public report:

37 (1) Describing the extent of the errors and delays.

38 (2) Offering recommendations to ensure that the

1 application of the SAVE program is not erroneously denying
2 benefits to individuals lawfully residing in the United
3 States pursuant to Federal law.
4 (c) Report.--An agency shall report errors under subsection
5 (b) to the Department of Homeland Security.
