36 fictitious names).

1 (5) The registration of State tax accounts with the
2 Department of Revenue.

3 (6) The registration of employer accounts with the
4 Department of Labor and Industry.

5 (7) The identification of points of contact for
6 political subdivisions which may have applicable local
7 registrations, permits, zoning requirements or other
8 requirements.
