Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the 10 Legion of Merit, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in 11 addition to the registration fee and any documentation the 12 department requires, the department shall issue to the person a 13 14 special registration plate designating the vehicle licensed as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Legion of Merit. 15 The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger 16 17 car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 18 14,000 pounds. Use and display of illuminated signs. 22 (c.1) Transportation network company driver. --23 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or regulation to the 24 25 contrary, but subject to 53 Pa.C.S. § 57A01 (relating to 26 definitions), a Transportation Network Company Driver may display an illuminated sign provided by a Transportation Network 27 Company within the interior of his or her vehicle so long as 28 such sign is approved by the Public Utility Commission or the 29 Philadelphia Parking Authority, as applicable.
