(3) If the officer views an offense that is a felony and makes a reasonable effort to identify himself or herself as a police officer.

(b) Applicability.--An agent of the Office of Attorney

General acting in accordance with the authority granted under this section shall be subject to section 8953(b), (c) and (d)

(relating to Statewide municipal police jurisdiction) to the same extent as would a municipal police officer.
