6 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known  
7 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a  
8 section to read:

9 Section 613.1. General Appropriation Bill Compensation  
10 Suspension.--(a) If the General Assembly fails to pass, or the  
11 Governor vetoes, a general appropriation bill for a fiscal year,  
12 compensation and reimbursement for expenses, including per  
13 diems, for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, cabinet officers  
14 and members of the General Assembly who are elected to  
15 leadership positions shall be suspended until a general  
16 appropriation bill has been passed by the General Assembly and  
17 signed by the Governor.

18 (b) Compensation and reimbursement for expenses, including  
19 per diems, shall be paid retroactively to the Governor,  
20 Lieutenant Governor, cabinet officer or member of the General  
21 Assembly for any service rendered between July 1 and the  
22 enactment of a general appropriation bill in any year in which  
23 the General Assembly has failed to pass or the Governor has  
24 failed to sign a general appropriation bill.
