

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 2067

1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 1 and 2, by striking out all of
2 said lines and inserting
3 Designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 73 in Philadelphia
4 County as the Police Officer Isabel Nazario Memorial Highway;
5 designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 29 in Montgomery
6 County as Leonard Joseph Taglieber Memorial Highway;
7 designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 41 (Gap Newport
8 Pike) between Pennsylvania Route 926 (Street Road) and U.S.
9 Route 1 located in London Grove Township and Londonderry
10 Township, Chester County, as the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec
11 Memorial Highway; designating a portion of State Route 2019,
12 known as Garrett Road, in Delaware County as the Deputy Chief
13 Michael P. Morgan Memorial Highway; designating a portion of
14 State Route 115 in Monroe County as the Submarine Veterans
15 Memorial Highway; and designating a bridge of that portion of
16 State Route 954 over the North Branch of Plum Creek, South
17 Mahoning Township, Indiana County, as the PFC William T.
18 Bresnock Memorial Bridge.

19 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 10 and 11

20 Section 2. Leonard Joseph Taglieber Memorial Highway.

21 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
22 follows:

23 (1) Lance Corporal Leonard Joseph Taglieber was born
24 April 11, 1946, and lived in East Greenville, Montgomery
25 County.

26 (2) Lance Corporal Taglieber enlisted in the United
27 States Marine Corps on November 15, 1965.

28 (3) In Vietnam, Lance Corporal Taglieber served with
29 Supply Company, 3d Service Battalion, FLSG-Alpha, Force
30 Logistical Command, III MAF.

31 (4) On June 23, 1967, Lance Corporal Taglieber, while
32 unloading ammunition at a dump site in Quang Tri Province,
33 Vietnam, was severely injured as a result of an explosion and
34 subsequent fire at the facility.

35 (5) On July 5, 1967, two weeks following the explosion,
36 Lance Corporal Taglieber succumbed to his injuries at a
37 military hospital in Japan.

1 (b) Designation.--The section of Pennsylvania Route 29 in
2 Montgomery County from Pennsylvania Route 663 to Tollgate Road
3 is designated the Leonard Joseph Taglieber Memorial Highway.

4 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
5 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
6 traffic in both directions on the highway.

7 Section 3. Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Highway.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) Trooper Kenton Iwaniec was born on December 18,
11 1983, in Greensburg, Westmoreland County, son of Ken and Deb
12 Iwaniec.

13 (2) Trooper Iwaniec graduated from Saint Vincent College
14 on May 11, 2007, and enlisted in the Pennsylvania State
15 Police on June 11, 2007.

16 (3) On March 27, 2008, Trooper Iwaniec finished his
17 shift at the Avondale Barracks in Chester County and began
18 his drive home.

19 (4) At approximately 10:15 p.m., just two miles away
20 from the Avondale Barracks, a vehicle driven by an impaired
21 driver crossed the centerline of Pennsylvania Route 41 and
22 hit Trooper Iwaniec's vehicle head-on.

23 (5) Trooper Iwaniec was flown to Christiana Hospital in
24 Delaware where he passed away two hours later from injuries
25 sustained in the collision.

26 (6) The family of Trooper Iwaniec continues to raise
27 awareness about the seriousness of impaired driving through
28 the formation of the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial
29 Foundation.

30 (7) The Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Foundation
31 encourages communities to have a positive influence in the
32 reduction of impaired driving.

33 (8) The mission of the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial
34 Foundation is to honor the memory of all victims of motorists
35 driving under the influence (DUI) and raise funds through
36 events to purchase preliminary breath-testing devices for the
37 Pennsylvania State Police and other law enforcement agencies
38 throughout this Commonwealth.

39 (b) Designation.-- A portion of Pennsylvania Route 41 (Gap
40 Newport Pike) between Pennsylvania Route 926 (Street Road) and
41 U.S. Route 1 located in London Grove Township and Londonderry
42 Township, Chester County, is designated the Trooper Kenton
43 Iwaniec Memorial Highway.

44 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
45 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
46 traffic in both directions on the highway.

47 Section 4. Deputy Chief Michael P. Morgan Memorial Highway.

48 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
49 follows:

50 (1) Deputy Chief Michael P. Morgan, a member of the
51 Garrettford-Drexel Hill Volunteer Fire Company, passed away

1 in the line of duty at the age of 48 on June 26, 2016.

2 (2) Deputy Chief Morgan joined the Clifton Heights Fire
3 Company as a junior member and served with the Garrettford-
4 Drexel Hill Volunteer Fire Company for 31 years.

5 (3) During his tenure, Deputy Chief Morgan served on the
6 board of directors and as lieutenant, captain and assistant
7 chief prior to becoming deputy chief of Company No. 20.

8 (b) Designation.--The section of State Route 2019, known as
9 Garrett Road, in Delaware County from Burmont Road to N.
10 Landsdowne Avenue is designated the Deputy Chief Michael P.
11 Morgan Memorial Highway.

12 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
13 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
14 traffic in both directions on the highway.

15 Section 5. Submarine Veterans Memorial Highway.

16 (a) Designation.--The section of State Route 115 from Long
17 Pond Road in Tunkhannock Township, Monroe County, to State
18 Road/Jonas Road in Chestnuthill Township, Monroe County, is
19 designated the Submarine Veterans Memorial Highway.

20 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
21 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
22 traffic in both directions on the highway.

23 Section 6. PFC William T. Bresnock Memorial Bridge.

24 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
25 follows:

26 (1) PFC William T. Bresnock was a native of South
27 Mahoning Township, Indiana County.

28 (2) PFC Bresnock was killed in action on December 23,
29 1944, during the Battle of the Bulge while serving in
30 Luxembourg with the United States Army, L Company, 109th
31 Infantry Regiment, 28th Infantry Division.

32 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 954 over
33 the North Branch of Plum Creek, South Mahoning Township, Indiana
34 County, is designated the PFC William T. Bresnock Memorial
35 Bridge.

36 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
37 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
38 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
