The balance of the proceeds shall be 23 24 subject to subsection (q). 25 (q) Use of cash or proceeds or property.--Cash or proceeds of forfeited property transferred under subsection (f) shall be 26 27 distributed in the following order: (1) To satisfy any restitution orders for victims of the 28 29 underlying offense. 30 (2) One of the following: 31 (i) if in the custody of the Attorney General, to 32 the Department of Revenue for deposit into the General 33 <u>Fund; or</u> (ii) if in the custody of the district attorney, to 34 35 the operating fund of the county in which the district_ attorney is elected. 36
