- (i) A cemetery may remove flags when flags become 24

1 unsightly or weatherworn any time on or after the first working day after Veterans' Day. Prior to Veterans' Day, 2 3 a cemetery may request replacement flags from the county 4 which may be used by the cemetery to replace weatherworn 5 flags, if such replacement flags are available. (ii) Notwithstanding subparagraph (i), a cemetery 6 7 may remove flags as a part of the cemetery's normal 8 course of maintenance not before the first working day 9 after Independence Day, but prior to Veterans' Day provided that the cemetery makes the flags available to 10 11 family members, veterans' organizations or other 12 community organizations for the purpose of decorating graves in recognition of Veterans' Day. 13 (2) A cemetery may remove flag holders for annual 14 15 storage upon the authorized removal of flags. 16 Amend Bill, page 241, lines 9 and 10, by striking out "An\_ 17 authority or person in charge of a cemetery" and inserting 18 Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person, other than a family member removing the flag from a deceased 19 20 relative's grave, 21 Amend Bill, page 241, by inserting between lines 14 and 15 22 (q) Exception. -- A cemetery or an owner, employee, agent or contractor of a cemetery who removes or causes the removal of a 23 flag, grave marker, headstone, flag holder or other memorial in 24 good faith in the course of maintenance, repair or mitigation of 25 damage shall not be subject to subsection (f) or section 1913-26 27 A(f).
