13 Section 124. Powers and Duties of the Secretary of

15 (c.1) (1) In addition to the requirements contained in the
16 "Regulatory Review Act" and the requirements contained in the
17 act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the
18 Commonwealth Documents Law, the Department of Education shall
19 submit to the the chair and minority chair of the Education
20 Committee of the Senate and the the chair and minority chair of
21 the Education Committee of the House of Representatives a fiscal
22 impact statement which describes in detail the impact that a
23 proposed regulation or final-form regulation would have on the
24 Commonwealth, taxpayers, school districts and, if applicable,
25 private schools and private religious schools. The fiscal impact
26 statement shall be submitted on the same date that the
27 Department of Education submits a proposed regulation to the
28 Legislative Reference Bureau for publication of notice of
29 proposed rulemaking in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. The fiscal
30 impact statement shall include a comprehensive itemization of
31 all direct and indirect costs, whether incurred in preparation
32 of the proposed or final-form regulation, contracting for

1 services or otherwise required to implement the regulation, to
2 the Department of Education's best estimate. The Department of
3 Education may include narrative statements to accompany an
4 estimate, but may not do so in lieu of a detailed estimate of
5 the amounts.

6 (2) On the same date the Department of Education submits the
7 text of a final-form regulation to the Independent Regulatory
8 Review Commission, the Department of Education shall submit to
9 the chair and minority chair of the Education Committee of the
10 Senate and the chair and minority chair of the Education
11 Committee of the House of Representatives an updated fiscal
12 impact statement which reflects any changes occurring during the
13 regulatory review process. Upon submission of a final-form
14 regulation, the Department of Education may submit, in lieu of
15 its own statement, the fiscal note prepared by the Office of the
16 Budget pursuant to section 612 of the act of April 9, 1929
17 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929."
