1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 16, by striking out "and"

2 Amend Bill, page 1, line 18, by striking out the period after
3 "Highway" and inserting

4 ; and designating a pedestrian bridge over that portion of State
5 Route 252, also known as Providence Road, between Stackhouse
6 Lane and Copples Lane in Nether Providence Township, Delaware
7 County, as the Jack Hontz Memorial Bridge.

8 Amend Bill, page 7, by inserting between lines 9 and 10

9 Section 7. Jack Hontz Memorial Bridge.

10 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
11 follows:

12 (1) Jack Hontz was a 1978 graduate of Newton High School
13 in Newton, New Jersey.

14 (2) He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in music
15 education and a Master of Arts degree in music performance
16 from West Chester University.

17 (3) In 1983, he began working at Wallingford-Swarthmore
18 School District where he formed Strath Haven High School's
19 new instrumental department and served as Department Chair
20 for the Fine Arts.

21 (4) For 34 years, he enthusiastically grew the Strath
22 Haven High School bands and orchestra, touching the lives of
23 generations of students.

24 (5) The accomplishments of his individual students and
25 the musical ensembles he was privileged to direct, including
26 the over 400 member Strath Haven High School Marching Band,
27 were a constant source of pride.

28 (6) Mr. Hontz also served as the musical advisor to the
29 Princeton University Band for 30 years, and as the conductor
30 of the Chester County Concert Band for 22 years.

31 (7) In 2016, Mr. Hontz was awarded the Distinguished
32 Music Alumnus Award by West Chester University.

33 (8) Jack Hontz passed away on June 23, 2017, at 57 years
34 of age.

35 (b) Designation.--The pedestrian bridge over State Route

1 252, also known as Providence Road, between Stackhouse Lane and
2 Copples Lane, in Nether Providence Township, Delaware County, is
3 designated as the Jack Hontz Memorial Bridge.

4 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
5 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
6 traffic in both directions of the bridge.
