2 (b) (1) If the parent or guardian chooses to share the
3 results of the screening with the school entity and the
4 screening indicates the presence of thoughts or behaviors often
5 associated with a diagnosis of depression, the school entity
6 shall refer the child:

7 (i) to the school's student assistance program;

8 (ii) to the school psychologist for evaluation; or

9 (iii) for evaluation under the Individuals with Disabilities
10 Education Act (Public Law 91-230, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq.) or
11 under section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Public Law
12 93-112, 29 U.S.C. § 794).

13 (2) The school entity shall notify the parent or guardian at
14 the point of referral that an evaluation under this subsection
15 will not be performed unless the parent or guardian consents to
16 the evaluation.
