25 (3) Other persons who are citizens of the United States, or 26 lawfully admitted aliens who are eligible for general 27 assistance.

28 (i) Persons who may be eligible for general assistance for

an indeterminate period as a result of medical, social or 1 2 related circumstances shall be limited to: 3 * * * 4 (C) A person who has been assessed by a physician or psychologist as having a verified physical or mental disability, 5 including a person who is a veteran and who has been diagnosed 6 with post-traumatic stress disorder, which temporarily or 7 permanently precludes him or her from any gainful employment. 8 9 The verification of the physical or mental disability must be established by written documentation in a form prescribed by the 10 11 department and must be based on acceptable clinical and 12 laboratory diagnostic techniques, rather than a statement of symptoms by the applicant or recipient[.]; except that, in the 13 case of a veteran, the verification of a diagnosis of post-14 15 traumatic stress disorder may be establish by a statement from the veteran's physician, psychologist or from the proper_ 16 military authority that has actual documented knowledge of the 17 veteran's diagnosis. The department may also require the 18 applicant or recipient to submit to an independent examination 19 20 as a condition of receiving assistance. An applicant or recipient with a verified physical or mental disability which is 21 22 temporary in nature shall pursue appropriate treatment as a 23 condition of receiving assistance. 24 * * *
