(relating to electronic signatures in global and 22 23 national commerce), the requirements of 49 U.S.C. § 32705 (relating to disclosure requirements on transfer of motor 24 vehicles) and any requirements imposed by the Commonwealth. The 25 26 department may, at its sole discretion, permit the use of a secure power of attorney as described in this subsection for the 27 transfer of other vehicles in addition to salvage vehicles. If 28 the secretary of the United States Department of Transportation 29 promulgates regulations regarding the use of a power of attorney 30 as described in this subsection, those regulations will 31

1 supersede this subsection in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 2 <u>32705(q)</u>.
