

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 632

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1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 27, by inserting after "attorney"
2 , licensed dealers

3 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 28 and 29, by striking out "or
4 insurer as defined in § 1702 (relating to definitions)"

5 Amend Bill, page 2, line 30, by striking out the bracket
6 before "when"

7 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 1 and 2, by striking out "] The
8 power of attorney need not be notarized and may be signed
9 electronically." and inserting
10 or the title has been lost by the transferer and the
11 licensed dealer is applying for a duplicate title.

12 Amend Bill, page 4, by inserting between lines 3 and 4
13 (d.2) Secure power of attorney, insurance companies.--The
14 department shall permit an insurer as defined in section 1702
15 (relating to definitions) to use a secure power of attorney to
16 transfer a salvage vehicle when the certificate of title is
17 encumbered with a lien or when the title has been lost by the
18 transferor and the insurer is applying for a duplicate title.
19 The power of attorney need not be notarized and may be signed
20 electronically. The insurer is responsible for ensuring the
21 power of attorney complies with the requirements of 15 U.S.C. §
22 7001 et seq. (relating to electronic signatures in global and
23 national commerce), the requirements of 49 U.S.C. § 32705
24 (relating to disclosure requirements on transfer of motor
25 vehicles) and any requirements imposed by the Commonwealth. The
26 department may, at its sole discretion, permit the use of a
27 secure power of attorney as described in this subsection for the
28 transfer of other vehicles in addition to salvage vehicles. If
29 the secretary of the United States Department of Transportation
30 promulgates regulations regarding the use of a power of attorney
31 as described in this subsection, those regulations will

1 supersede this subsection in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §
2 32705(g).

3 Amend Bill, page 4, line 4, by striking out "(d.2)" and
4 inserting

5 (d.3)

6 Amend Bill, page 4, lines 8 through 13, by striking out all
7 of said lines and inserting

8 (d.4) Electronic secure power of attorney.--The department
9 may, at its sole discretion, permit the use of a secure power of
10 attorney signed electronically as described in subsection (d.2)
11 for the transfer of vehicles by licensed dealers.
