One thousand cubic feet of natural gas at a temperature of 60 degrees Fahrenheit and an absolute pressure of 20 21 14.73 pounds per square inch, in accordance with American Gas 22 Association standards and according to Boyle's law for the 23 measurement of gas under varying pressures with deviations therefrom as follows: 24 25 (1) The average absolute atmospheric pressure shall be assumed to be 14.4 pounds to the square inch, notwithstanding 26 27 the actual elevation or location of point of delivery above 28 sea level or variations in the atmospheric pressure. (2) The temperature of the gas passing the meters shall 29 30 be determined by the continuous use of a recording thermometer installed so that the thermometer may properly 31 32 record the temperature of the gas flowing through the meters. 33 The arithmetic average of the temperature recorded each 24-34 hour day shall be used in computing gas volumes. If a 35 recording thermometer is not installed, or if installed and 36 not operating properly, an average flowing temperature of 60 37 degrees Fahrenheit shall be used in computing gas volume. 38 (3) The specific gravity of the gas shall be determined by tests made by the use of an Edwards or Acme gravity 39 balance annually or at intervals as are found necessary in 40 41 practice. Specific gravity shall be used in computing gas 42 volumes. 43 (4) The deviation of the natural gas from Boyle's law shall be determined by tests annually or at other shorter 44 intervals as are found necessary in practice. and the method to be used in making the tests shall be in
