1 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 5 through 7, by striking out all of

5 "Fertilizer." A chemical product derived from petrochemicals  
6 which is added to soil or land to increase fertility.  
7 "Natural gas." As defined in 58 Pa.C.S. § 2301 (relating to  
8 definitions).

9 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 2 and 3, by striking out all of  
10 said lines and inserting

11 "Petrochemical." Chemical products obtained from refining  
12 and processing natural gas.

13 Amend Bill, page 3, line 5, by striking out "VI,"

6 (4) Has made good faith efforts to recruit and employ,  
7 and to encourage any contractors or subcontractors to recruit  
8 and employ, workers from the local labor market for  
9 employment during the construction phase.

10 (5) Has demonstrated that individuals employed by the  
11 taxpayer or any contractor or subcontractor for the  
12 construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration or  
13 repair of the facility have been paid the prevailing minimum  
14 wage rate for each craft or classification as determined by  
15 the Department of Labor and Industry under the act of August  
16 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania  
17 Prevailing Wage Act.

18 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 20 and 21

19 "Unit." One thousand cubic feet of natural gas at a  
20 temperature of 60 degrees Fahrenheit and an absolute pressure of  
21 14.73 pounds per square inch, in accordance with American Gas  
22 Association standards and according to Boyle's law for the  
23 measurement of gas under varying pressures with deviations  
24 therefrom as follows:

25 (1) The average absolute atmospheric pressure shall be  
26 assumed to be 14.4 pounds to the square inch, notwithstanding  
27 the actual elevation or location of point of delivery above  
28 sea level or variations in the atmospheric pressure.

29 (2) The temperature of the gas passing the meters shall  
30 be determined by the continuous use of a recording  
31 thermometer installed so that the thermometer may properly  
32 record the temperature of the gas flowing through the meters.  
33 The arithmetic average of the temperature recorded each 24-  
34 hour day shall be used in computing gas volumes. If a  
35 recording thermometer is not installed, or if installed and  
36 not operating properly, an average flowing temperature of 60  
37 degrees Fahrenheit shall be used in computing gas volume.

38 (3) The specific gravity of the gas shall be determined  
39 by tests made by the use of an Edwards or Acme gravity  
40 balance annually or at intervals as are found necessary in  
41 practice. Specific gravity shall be used in computing gas  
42 volumes.

43 (4) The deviation of the natural gas from Boyle's law  
44 shall be determined by tests annually or at other shorter  
45 intervals as are found necessary in practice. The apparatus  
46 and the method to be used in making the tests shall be in

1 accordance with recommendations of the National Bureau of  
2 Standards of the Department of Commerce or Report No. 3 of  
3 the Gas Measurement Committee of the American Gas  
4 Association, or any amendments thereof. The results of the  
5 tests shall be used in computing the volume of gas delivered.
