4 (c) Consolidated standards permit.--A person conducting
5 remediation activities under this act may obtain a consolidated
6 standards permit. The following shall apply:

7 (1) A person who is issued a consolidated standards
8 permit in connection with the remediation activities under
9 this act is not required to obtain a permit, license, plan
10 approval or other approval in connection with the activity
11 under the act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as
12 The Clean Streams Law, the act of January 8, 1960 (1959
13 P.L.2119, No.787), known as the Air Pollution Control Act,
14 the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known as the Solid
15 Waste Management Act, the act of July 13, 1988 (P.L.525,
16 No.93), referred to as the Infectious and Chemotherapeutic
17 Waste Law, the act of July 6, 1989 (P.L.169, No.32), known as
18 the Storage Tank and Spill Prevention Act or other Federal
19 statutes relating to environmental protection or the
20 protection of public health. A person who obtains a
21 consolidated standards permit under this subsection is deemed
22 to be in compliance with the requirement to obtain a permit,
23 license, plan approval or other approval in connection with
24 the activity under the applicable provisions of those acts
25 and regulations.

26 (2) The department shall grant or deny a consolidated
27 standards permit within 120 calendar days from its receipt of
28 an application. The department may extend the review under
29 this paragraph to comply with required Federal notice
30 requirements.

31 (3) No later than January 1 of each year, the department
32 shall submit a report to the Environmental Resources and
33 Energy Committee of the Senate and the Environmental
34 Resources and Energy Committee of the House of
35 Representatives on the utilization of the consolidated
36 standards permit.
