

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1170

1 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 5 through 10, by striking out all  
2 of said lines and inserting

3 "Construction industry employer." As follows:

4 (1) An individual, entity or organization in the  
5 construction industry, which:

6 (i) transacts business in this Commonwealth; and

7 (ii) employs at least one employee in this  
8 Commonwealth.

9 (2) The term includes a staffing agency that supplies  
10 workers to a construction industry employer.

11 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 28 through 30; page 3, lines 1  
12 through 4; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and  
13 inserting

14 "License." As follows:

15 (1) A permit, certificate, approval, registration,  
16 charter or similar form of authorization that is required by  
17 law and issued by an agency for the purposes of:

18 (i) operating a business in this Commonwealth;

19 (ii) conducting operations in the construction  
20 industry; or

21 (iii) completing a specific construction project.

22 (2) The term includes articles of incorporation and  
23 domestic or foreign entity registrations under 15 Pa.C.S.  
24 (relating to corporations and unincorporated associations).

25 (3) The term does not include a professional or  
26 occupational license or certificate granted to an individual  
27 to engage in a profession or trade.

28 Amend Bill, page 3, line 26, by inserting after "DEPARTMENT."

29 The department shall have the authority to investigate  
30 complaints under this act. Pursuant to an investigation of a  
31 complaint, the department may:

32 (1) Enter and inspect the place of business or place of  
33 employment of any employer of employees in any occupation in  
34 this Commonwealth at any reasonable time, for the purpose of

1 examining and inspecting records of the employer that in any  
2 way relate to compliance with this act.

3 (2) Copy any or all records as the department may deem  
4 necessary or appropriate.

5 (3) Require from an employer full and accurate  
6 statements in writing, at such times as the department may  
7 deem necessary, of the work authorization verification  
8 process for all employees in the employer's employment.

9 (4) Interrogate persons for the purpose of ascertaining  
10 whether an employer has complied with this act.

11 Amend Bill, page 4, line 7, by striking out the period after  
12 "3(a)" and inserting

13 if all the information required to complete the form has  
14 been provided, including the name of the person filing the  
15 complaint.

16 Amend Bill, page 10, line 13, by inserting after "UPON"  
17 court-ordered sanctions for

18 Amend Bill, page 10, line 19, by striking out "~~in 60 days~~  
19 JULY 1, 2020" and inserting

20 in one year
