1 Amend Bill, page 10, by inserting between lines 17 and 18

2 Section 8. Report on E-verify program.

3 (a) Report.--The Legislative Budget and Finance Committee  
4 shall conduct a study and compile a report on E-verify program.  
5 The report shall include all of the following information:

6 (1) An evaluation of the effectiveness of the E-Verify  
7 program as a deterrent to violations of any of the following:

8 (i) The act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known  
9 as the Workers' Compensation Act.

10 (ii) The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937  
11 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation  
12 Law.

13 (iii) The act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, No.329),  
14 known as the Wage Payment and Collection Law.

15 (iv) The act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.11, No.5),  
16 known as The Minimum Wage Act of 1968.

17 (v) The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as  
18 the Tax Reform Code of 1971.

19 (vi) The act of October 13, 2010 (P.L.506, No.72),  
20 known as the Construction Workplace Misclassification  
21 Act.

22 (vii) Any other applicable laws of this  
23 Commonwealth.

24 (2) A review of the use, enforcement and effectiveness  
25 of the E-Verify program by the Federal Government and other  
26 states.

27 (3) Any additional powers, duties or requirements that  
28 may be necessary to effectively implement this act and deter  
29 violation of the laws specified under paragraph (1).

30 (4) The impact of the E-Verify program on State,  
31 regional and local employment, wages and working conditions.

32 (5) The impact of the E-Verify program on workers,  
33 families and minority groups and recommendations on how to  
34 avoid discrimination or disenfranchisement of individuals.

35 (6) Recommendations on best practices in employer  
36 training or educational outreach to ensure the consistent and  
37 lawful use of the E-Verify program throughout this  
38 Commonwealth.

1 (b) Submission.--The Legislative Budget and Finance  
2 Committee shall submit the report to the General Assembly within  
3 18 months of the effective date of this section.
