27 within its geographic bounds a former military
28 installation where activities caused per- and
29 polyfluoroalkyl public drinking water contamination, the
30 member shall be a member of the governing body.

31 (iii) If either subparagraph (i) or (ii) do not
32 apply, the President pro tempore of the Senate shall
33 appoint a permanent resident or residents of the
34 appropriate municipality to the governing body.

35 (2) Two members subject to the following:

36 (i) If a member of the House of Representatives has
37 a permanent residence in the qualified municipality, the
38 member shall be a member of the governing body.

1 (ii) If a member of the House of Representatives has
2 a permanent residence in a municipality which is
3 immediately adjacent to a qualified municipality and that
4 municipality has within its geographic bounds a former
5 military installation where activities caused per- and
6 polyfluoroalkyl public drinking water contamination, the
7 member shall be a member of the governing body.

8 (iii) If either subparagraph (i) or (ii) do not
9 apply, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
10 appoint a permanent resident or residents of the
11 appropriate municipality to the governing body.
