22 Section 408.12. Wine and Spirits Auction Permits.--(a) Upon
23 application of:

24 (1) any nonprofit hospital;

25 (2) any nonprofit public television station which is a
26 member of the Pennsylvania Public Television Network;

27 (3) any orchestra located in a county of the first, second
28 or third class which is operated by a nonprofit corporation;

1 (4) any museum located in a county of the first, second,
2 third or fourth class which is operated by a nonprofit
3 corporation;

4 (5) any nonprofit corporation located in any county of the
5 third class which trains and places dogs for people who are
6 physically handicapped;

7 (6) any nationally recognized community-based voluntary
8 health organization committed to fighting cancer which has been
9 in existence for at least ninety years;

10 (7) any nationally recognized emergency response
11 organization that offers humanitarian care to victims of war or
12 natural disaster and has been in existence for at least one
13 hundred twenty-five years;

14 (8) any nationally recognized organization whose purpose is
15 to serve as an agent to collect funds for local charities, as
16 well as to coordinate relief services, counsel and refer clients
17 to cooperating agencies and make emergency assistance grants and
18 has been in existence for at least one hundred twenty years;

19 (9) any hospice as defined under section 802.1 of the act of
20 July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the "Health Care
21 Facilities Act";

22 (10) institution of higher education;

23 (11) any nationally recognized community-based health
24 organization committed to funding Type 1 Diabetes research; [or]

25 (12) any nationally recognized community-based voluntary
26 health organization committed to fighting cancer which has been
27 in existence for at least twenty years;

28 (13) any nonprofit organization as defined in section 501(c)
29 (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26
30 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3)) and that is registered with the Pennsylvania
31 Bureau of Corporations and Charitable Organizations of the
32 Department of State, recognized as a community-based voluntary
33 organization committed to fighting cancer and has been in
34 existence for at least five years; or

35 (14) any community-based voluntary health organization in a
36 county of the second class which enriches the lives of children
37 and young adults with disabilities and chronic illnesses;

38 and upon payment of a fee of thirty dollars (\$30) per day, the
39 board shall issue a wine and spirits auction permit good for a
40 period of not more than four consecutive or nonconsecutive days
41 per calendar year.

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
