

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1589

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 16, by inserting after "laws," "
2 in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions;
3 and,

4 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 23 through 25, by striking out all
5 of said lines and inserting

6 Section 1. The definition of "performing arts facilities" in
7 section 102 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known
8 as the Liquor Code, is amended to read:

9 Section 102. Definitions.--The following words or phrases,
10 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, shall have the
11 meanings ascribed to them in this section:

12 * * *

13 "Performing arts facilities" shall mean [those] any of the
14 following:

15 (1) Those halls or theaters in which live musical, concert,
16 dance, ballet and legitimate play book-length productions are
17 performed. Performing arts facilities shall not mean those halls
18 or theaters in which burlesque shows or reviews are performed.
19 If the operator of the performing arts facility is a nonprofit
20 entity, the facility must have seating for at least one hundred
21 fifty (150) people; otherwise, the facility must have seating
22 for at least twenty-five hundred (2,500) people.

23 (2) Small movie theaters that have permanent seating in the
24 facility for at least one hundred (100) people, but no more than
25 three hundred fifty (350) people, and which screen independent
26 films, foreign films, classic films and second-run films on no
27 more than four movie screens. As used in this definition, the
28 term "independent films" includes feature films produced outside
29 the major film studio system or by independent entertainment
30 agencies.

31 (3) A hall or theater that meets the requirements of
32 paragraphs (1) and (2).

34 Section 2. Sections 406(d), 412(f)(1) and 413(f)(1) of the
35 act are amended to read:

36 Amend Bill, page 3, line 15, by inserting after "facility."

1 In addition, sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages at
2 a movie theater as defined under paragraph (2) or (3) of the
3 definition of "performing arts facilities" in section 102 may be
4 made one hour before, during and one hour after the screening of
5 any independent, foreign, classic or second-run film at the
6 movie theater.
