1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 17, by striking out "'residual
2 waste,'"

3 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 18 and 19, by striking out ",
4 amended February 15, 2018 (P.L.19, No.7),"

5 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 25 and 26

6 "Advanced recycling." A manufacturing process for the
7 conversion of post-use polymers through processes, including
8 pyrolysis, gasification, depolymerization, catalytic cracking,
9 reforming, hydrogenation and other similar technologies, into
10 any of the following:

11 (1) Basic hydrocarbon raw materials, feedstocks,
12 chemicals, liquid fuels, waxes and lubricants.

13 (2) Other products, including, but not limited to,
14 monomers, oligomers, plastics, crude oil, naphtha, liquid
15 transportation fuels and other basic hydrocarbons.

16 "Advanced recycling facility." A manufacturing facility that
17 receives post-use polymers and separates, stores and converts
18 the post-use polymers using advanced recycling. The term does
19 not include a resource recovery facility, processing facility,
20 municipal waste processing or disposal facility or any other
21 facility that receives unsorted municipal waste for the purpose
22 of separating out post-use polymers for use in advanced
23 recycling.

3 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 29 and 30; page 4, lines 1 through
4 13; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and
5 inserting

6 "Post-use polymers." Post-use plastic derived from any
7 residential, municipal or commercial source that would not
8 otherwise be recycled, including source-separated recyclable
9 plastics from a materials recycling facility, that is not mixed
10 with solid waste, municipal waste, residual waste, regulated
11 medical and chemotherapeutic waste, hazardous waste, electronic
12 waste, waste tires or construction or demolition waste and may
13 contain incidental contaminants or impurities, such as paper
14 labels or metal rings. For the purpose of this act, post-use
15 polymers that are converted using advanced recycling shall not
16 be considered solid waste, municipal waste or residual waste.

17 Amend Bill, page 4, lines 28 through 30; page 5, lines 1

19 said lines on said pages and inserting

20 (ii) The conversion of post-use polymers through
21 advanced recycling in which the manufacturing activities,
22 handling of the post-use polymers at an advanced
23 recycling facility and the products and by-products of
24 the advanced recycling conversion comply with all
25 applicable Environmental Protection Agency and department
26 rules and regulations.

27 Amend Bill, page 7, lines 9 through 11, by striking out all
28 of said lines

29 Amend Bill, page 7, lines 21 through 23, by striking out "the
30 conversion of post" in line 21 and all of lines 22 and 23 and
31 inserting

32 the conversion of post-use polymers through advanced
33 recycling in which the manufacturing activities, handling of the
34 post-use polymers at an advanced recycling facility and the
35 products and by-products of the advanced recycling conversion
36 comply with all applicable Environmental Protection Agency and
37 department rules and regulations.
