14 This chapter relates to enforcement officer disability
15 benefits relating to COVID-19.

16 § 5702. Enforcement officer disability benefits.

17 (a) General rule.--A person covered under section 1(a) of
18 the act of June 28, 1935 (P.L.477, No.193), referred to as the
19 Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law, who contracts or is
20 diagnosed with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), as
21 identified in the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by
22 the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March
23 21, 2020), or is subject to quarantine resulting from exposure
24 to COVID-19, and by reason thereof is temporarily incapacitated
25 from performing his duties, shall be compensated in accordance
26 with section 1(a) of the the Enforcement Officer Disability
27 Benefits Law.

28 (b) Limitation.--A benefit received under subsection (a)
29 shall be limited to 60 days for each incident.
