7 (1.1) To provide training for police officers with  
8 respect to:

9 (i) Recognition of mental illness, intellectual  
10 disabilities and autism.

11 (ii) Proper techniques to interact with and de-  
12 escalate individuals engaging in behavior indicative of  
13 mental illness, intellectual disability or autism.

14 (iii) Instruction on services available to  
15 individuals with mental illness, intellectual  
16 disabilities or autism.

17 (iv) Instruction on interacting with individuals of  
18 diverse racial, ethnic and economic backgrounds.

20 (6) To require every police officer to attend a minimum  
21 number of hours of in-service training as provided for by  
22 regulation to maintain certification by the commission,  
23 unless the officer's employer files a show cause document  
24 with the commission requesting additional time for the  
25 officer to comply with the in-service training requirements.  
26 Approval of this request shall be made by the commission on a  
27 case-by-case basis. In-service training shall require annual  
28 instruction on the use of force, including deadly force, de-  
29 escalation and harm reduction techniques, and shall include  
30 on a biennial basis instruction in community and cultural  
31 awareness, implicit bias, procedural justice and  
32 reconciliation techniques as developed by the commission.
