26 satisfactory proof of:

27 (1) four or more years of progressive experience in

1 engineering work performed after the [issuance of the engineer-
2 in-training certificate] successful completion of the
3 fundamentals of engineering examination and under the
4 supervision of a professional engineer or a similarly qualified
5 engineer of a grade and character to fit him to assume
6 responsible charge of the work involved in the practice of
7 engineering; or

8 (2) four or more years of progressive teaching experience in
9 an approved curriculum under the supervision of a professional
10 engineer or a similarly qualified engineer of a grade or
11 character to fit him to assume responsible charge of the work
12 involved in the practice of engineering.
