

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 2355

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1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 4 and 5, by striking out "duties of
2 medical assistance managed care organizations" and inserting
3 medical assistance managed care organization rate setting

4 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 11 through 19; pages 2 and 3, lines
5 1 through 30; page 4, lines 1 through 7; by striking out all of
6 said lines on said pages and inserting

7 Section 449.1. Medical Assistance Managed Care Organization
8 Rate Setting.--(a) The department shall annually adjust the
9 medical assistance managed care organization financial reporting
10 that is used as the basis of rate setting by the value of
11 provider-preventable conditions in no less than facility place
12 of service paid by the medical assistance managed care
13 organization to ensure that Federal and State funds are not used
14 to pay for improper payments.

15 (b) The department shall annually report the value of
16 adjustments by the medical assistance managed care organization
17 under subsection (a) as part of the reports required under
18 Article V-A.

24 "Provider-preventable conditions" means any conditions
25 occurring in a health care setting that meet the following
26 criteria:

27 (1) Is identified in the State plan in line with the fee-
28 for-service model.

29 (2) Has been found by the Commonwealth, based upon a review
30 of medical literature by qualified professionals, to be
31 reasonably preventable through the application of procedures

- 1 supported by evidence-based guidelines.
- 2 (3) Has a negative consequence for the patient.
- 3 (4) Is auditable.
- 4 (5) Includes, at a minimum, any of the following:
- 5 (i) A wrong surgical or other invasive procedure performed
- 6 on a patient.
- 7 (ii) A surgical or other invasive procedure performed on the
- 8 wrong body part.
- 9 (iii) A surgical or other invasive procedure performed on
- 10 the wrong patient.
