(a) General rule.—A corporation for profit and a corporation not-for-profit shall be permitted, under a declaration by the Governor of disaster emergency under 35  Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority of Governor) on or before March 6, 2020, to transition to contactless and curbside business operations for the duration of the declaration of disaster emergency. The following shall apply:  (1) A corporation for profit and corporation not-for-profit shall:  (i) Comply with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Interim Guidance for Businesses and
