(a) General rule. -- The Secretary of Community and Economic 7 Development shall immediately issue a waiver to the Governor's 8 20200319 TWW COVID-19 Business Closure Order to all providers of 9 legal services, and residential and commercial real estate 10 services, including settlement services, that comply with 11 section 102-A. 12 13 (b) Other real estate actions. -- Until the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, 14 published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of 15 the state of disaster emergency, is terminated or expires under 16 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority of 17 18 Governor): 19 (1) A municipality or municipal authority that requires 20 a use and occupancy certificate, or any other similar 21 certificate or certification as a condition of a property 22 transfer, shall be presumed to have issued a full and unconditional permit without requiring an inspection of the 23 24 property. If a certificate is presumed to be issued, the municipality or municipal authority shall be enjoined from 25 conducting a property transfer inspection after the 26 27 proclamation has terminated or expired. (2) Taxing authorities and public utilities shall 28 29 provide alternative means for residential home buyers or 30 title insurers to ascertain the current status of tax

(c) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "providers of residential and commercial real estate services" shall mean:

payments or overdue utility obligations.

(3) Any other professional contractor, inspector or 3 other service provider that is providing an inspection that 4 is included as a contingent provision of a real estate 5 agreement of transfer or lease. 6 (4) Real estate appraisers. 7 (5) Photographers or videographers engaged in collecting 8 digital media for real estate marketing purposes. 9 (6) Title agents, attorneys and notaries providing 10 settlement services. 11 Section 102-A. Compliance. 12 A business shall adhere to social distancing practices and other mitigation measures defined by the Centers for Disease 13 Control to protect workers and to mitigate the spread of the 14 15 COVID-19 virus and the order of the Secretary of Health directing public health safety measures for businesses permitted 16 17 to maintain in-person operations. Section 103-A. Effect of subsequent orders. 18 A waiver granted under this article shall remain valid 19 20 notwithstanding any order issued pursuant to the declaration of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, 21 published in 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), or any renewal 22 23 thereof, unless the order removes any of the restrictions or

otherwise grants greater permissions for operations than are

provided under this article.

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
