The act of October 26, 2016 (P.L.891, No.112), 15 known as the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Act, is 16 amended by adding a section to read: Section 2.1. Criminal background checks for expedited licensure 17 18 applicants. 19 (a) Submission. -- For the purpose of administering the criminal history background check required under Article V of 20 section 2 of the compact, the member board of this State shall 21 require an applicant for an expedited license under the compact_ 22 to submit to a criminal history background check conducted by_ 23 the Pennsylvania State Police. The applicant shall submit 24 fingerprints and other identifying information to the 25 Pennsylvania State Police. The member board of this State shall 26 27 not consider an applicant for an expedited license who refuses to comply with this subsection. 28 29 (b) Duties of Pennsylvania State Police. -- In order to assist the member board of this State in reviewing the criminal history 30 31 background of an applicant for an expedited license, the Pennsylvania State Police or its designee shall do the 32 following: 33 34 (1) Provide the member board with a report of the applicant's criminal history record information as defined in 35

14	the information authorized to be disseminated under 18

16	<u>(c) Use of criminal history record informationCriminal</u>
17	history record information obtained by the member board of this
18	<u>State under this section shall be interpreted and used only to</u>
19	determine an applicant's eligibility for an expedited license.
