8 (b) To select [and], equip and clean polling places that
9 meet the requirements of this act. For the duration of the
10 Governor's 20200319 TWW COVID-19 Business Closure Order, a
11 polling place shall be cleaned and maintained to comply with the
12 mitigation measures defined by the Centers For Disease Control
13 and Prevention and the order of the Secretary of Health
14 directing public health and safety measures to protect election
15 officers and electors who appear to vote from the spread of the
16 COVID-19 virus and a county board shall, at a minimum, provide
17 the following:

18 (1) Cleaning areas with adequate soap and water.

19 (2) Appropriate new personal protective equipment.

20 Personal protective equipment shall include, but not be
21 limited to, hand sanitizer, gloves, masks, an adequate supply
22 of disposable pens and pencils and cleaning products which
23 shall be utilized on all surfaces touched by an elector.

24 (3) An environment that maximizes the safety of election
25 officers and electors who appear to vote, including, but not
26 limited to, social distancing and barriers.
