17 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
18 review data collected and disseminated by the Department of
19 Health and issue a report of its findings; and be it further

20 RESOLVED, That the report include, but not be limited to, a
21 review of all of the following:

22 (1) The number and type of COVID-19 tests completed in
23 this Commonwealth, including a review of all of the
24 following:

25 (i) Information on the commingling of test results
26 for polymerase chain reaction tests and antibody tests.

27 (ii) The data system used to ensure COVID-19

1 positive tests from the same individual were not reported
2 as multiple positive cases.

3 (ii) The type of COVID-19 tests completed, including
4 polymerase chain reaction tests, antibody tests and rapid
5 antigen tests.

6 (2) The policies, procedures and practices of State
7 agencies reporting COVID-19 test results to the Department of
8 Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
9 including a review of all of the following:

10 (i) The COVID-19 reporting requirements of State
11 agencies, health care facilities and other long-term care
12 facilities to determine if duplication of reporting
13 through multiple data systems has resulted in more
14 accurate data or a duplication of information.

15 (ii) Laboratory reporting for COVID-19 to the
16 Department of Health to determine why there are delays in
17 reporting COVID-19 information to Department of Health or
18 by the Department of Health that has resulted in delays
19 of information being reported on the Department of
20 Health's COVID-19 dashboard.

21 (iii) The procedures utilized by the Department of
22 Health to revise positive COVID-19 test results and
23 COVID-19 deaths in daily reporting or on the Department
24 of Health's COVID-19 dashboard.

25 (3) The death certificates for residents of this
26 Commonwealth who may have died from COVID-19 to ensure the
27 deaths were properly, accurately and consistently reported to
28 Department of Health;
29 and be it further

30 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
31 include any additional information in its report as deemed
32 necessary to effectuate the purposes of this resolution; and be
33 it further
