Reports by Business Entities; Publication by 3 Secretary of the Commonwealth.--(a) Any business entity including but not limited to a 4 5 corporation, company, association, partnership or sole 6 proprietorship, which has been awarded non-bid contracts from 7 the Commonwealth or its political subdivisions during the 8 preceding calendar year, shall report <u>electronically in</u> 9 <u>accordance with section 1631.1</u> by February 15 of each year to 10 the Secretary of the Commonwealth an itemized list of all political contributions known to the business entity by virtue 11 of the knowledge possessed by every officer, director, 12 13 associate, partner, limited partner or individual owner that has been made by: 14 15 (1) any officer, director, associate, partner, limited 16 partner, individual owner or members of their immediate family when the contributions exceed an aggregate of one thousand 17 dollars (\$1,000) by any individual during the preceding year; or 18 19 (2) any employe or members of his immediate family whose 20 political contribution exceeded one thousand dollars (\$1,000) during the preceding year. 21 For the purposes of this subsection, "immediate family" means a 22 person's spouse and any unemancipated child. 23 * * * 24 Amend Bill, page 10, line 22, by striking out "90" and 25 26 inserting

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
