- (5) heterogeneously dense breast tissue based on breast 28
- 29 composition categories of the Breast Imaging and Reporting Data
- System established by the American College of Radiology with any 30
- 31 one of the following risk factors:
- (i) lifetime risk of breast cancer of greater than 20%, 32
- according to risk assessment tools based on family history; 33
- 34 (ii) personal history of BRCA1 or BRCA2 gene mutations;
- (iii) first-degree relative with a BRCA1 or BRCA2 gene 35

mutation but not having had genetic testing herself;

2 <u>(iv) prior therapeutic thoracic radiation therapy between 10</u> 3 and 30 years of age; or

- 4 (v) personal history of Li-Fraumeni syndrome, Cowden
  5 syndrome or Bannayan-Riley-Ruvalcaba syndrome or a first-degree
  6 relative with one of these syndromes.
- 7 (6) extremely dense breast tissue based on breast
  8 composition categories of the Breast Imaging and Reporting Data
  9 System established by the American College of Radiology. Nothing
- 10 <u>in this subsection shall be construed to require an insurer to</u>
- 11 cover the surgical procedure known as mastectomy or to prevent
- 12 the application of deductible, copayment or coinsurance
