1 Amend Bill, page 13, by inserting between lines 7 and 8

2 (5) Develop, adopt or otherwise make available within
3 180 days of the effective date of this section a training
4 module for school police, school resource officers and school
5 security guards related to children and adolescent
6 development. The following shall apply:

7 (i) All school security personnel employed or
8 assigned in this capacity shall be required to complete
9 this training every three years from the date of
10 curriculum adoption by the commission. The school entity
11 may require additional training as needed.

12 (ii) The commission shall review the training module
13 every two years at a minimum in order to update the
14 training as needed.

15 (iii) The training shall be a minimum of eight hours
16 and may be supplemented by additional training that the
17 school entity deems necessary.

18 (iv) The training may be used for professional
19 development requirements.

20 (v) At a minimum, the training must include
21 instruction on:

22 (A) Cultural, racial, religious, ethnicity, sex,
23 sexual orientation and identification, disability and
24 mental health considerations consistent with school-
25 aged students and building positive relationships
26 with these students and the school community.

27 (B) The impacts of trauma, crisis intervention
28 and de-escalation techniques specifically related to
29 school-aged students, including methods for limiting
30 the use of force and the deployment of physical,
31 mechanical and chemical restraints.

32 (C) Emergency planning considerations and age-
33 appropriate school safety instruction training,
34 including for students with mental health,
35 disabilities or other behavioral health needs.

36 (D) Positive behavioral interventions and
37 supports, conflict resolution techniques and
38 restorative justice practices.
