

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 869

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 6, by striking out the period after  
2 "anniversary" and inserting  
3 and for moment of silence on December 7, Pearl Harbor Day.

4 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 9 through 11, by striking out all

6 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  
7 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding sections  
8 to read:

10 Section 1556. Moment of silence on December 7, Pearl Harbor  
11 Day.--(a) Beginning with school year 2021-2022 and any  
12 subsequent school year when Pearl Harbor Day occurs on a school  
13 day, each school entity shall conduct a moment of silence during  
14 instructional hours for students and faculty to observe the  
15 anniversary of Pearl Harbor Day as a remembrance of the 3,546  
16 military service persons who lost their lives or were wounded by  
17 the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941.

18 (b) Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, the Department  
19 of Education shall make available to all school entities  
20 voluntary in-service training programs based upon the moment of  
21 silence provided for under subsection (a) and model curriculum  
22 guidelines.

23 (c) The Department of Education shall provide the model  
24 guidelines, voluntary in-service training and any other  
25 materials developed in accordance with this section to any  
26 nonpublic school within this Commonwealth upon receiving a  
27 request from the nonpublic school.

28 (d) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"  
29 shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter  
30 school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or career and  
31 technical school.
