Short title of chapter. 18 This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the Uniform 19 Unsworn [Foreign] Declarations Act. 20 § 6202. Definitions. 21 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 22 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 23 24 ["Boundaries of the United States." The geographic 25
 - boundaries of the United States, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and any territory or insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the United States. 1
- "Law." Includes [the Federal or a state constitution, a 28 29 Federal or state] <u>a</u> statute, [a] judicial decision or order, [a] rule of court, [an] executive order and [an] administrative 30 rule, regulation or order. 31
- "Record." Information that is inscribed on a tangible medium 32 33 or that is stored in an electronic or other medium and is retrievable in perceivable form. 34
- 35 "Sign." With present intent to authenticate or adopt a

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record: (1) to execute or adopt a tangible symbol; or 2 3 (2) to attach to or logically associate with the record 4 an electronic symbol, sound or process. ["State." A state of the United States, the District of 5 Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands or any territory or 7 insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the United States.1 9 "Sworn declaration." A declaration in a signed record given 10 under oath. The term includes a sworn statement, verification, 11 certificate and affidavit. 12 "Unsworn declaration." A declaration in a signed record [that is] not given under oath but [is] given under penalty of 13 14 perjury. 15 § 6203. Applicability. This chapter applies to an unsworn declaration by a declarant 16 who at the time of making the declaration is physically located 17 within or outside the boundaries of the United States whether or 18 not the location is subject to the jurisdiction of the United 19 States. [This chapter does not apply to a declaration by a 20 declarant who is physically located on property that is within 21 22 the boundaries of the United States and subject to the 23 jurisdiction of another country or a federally recognized Indian 24 tribe. § 6206. Form of unsworn declaration. 25 An unsworn declaration under this chapter must be in 26 27 substantially the following form: 28 I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of the 29 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that the foregoing is true and correct.[, and that I am physically located outside 30 31 the geographic boundaries of the United States, Puerto 32 Rico, the Virgin Islands and any territory or insular 33 possession subject to the jurisdiction of the United 34 States. 35 Executed] <u>Signed</u> on the......day of....., 36 at...., 37 (date) (month) (year) 38 39 40 (country)..... 41 (printed name)..... 42

- 15 Section 5. Upon the effective date of this section, the
- 16 Department of State shall immediately authorize a notary public
- 17 to conduct notarial acts in the manner authorized by 57 Pa.C.S.
- 18 § 314.1, provided the notary gives notice to the department as
- 19 required by 57 Pa.C.S. § 314.1(g)(1) and uses a communication
- 20 and identity proofing technology designated in the department's
- 21 March 25, 2020 notice of the limited suspension of the
- 22 requirements of 57 Pa.C.S. § 306, or that is designated in a
- 23 list of additional acceptable technologies subsequently adopted
- 24 by the department. A notary public may use any other technology
- 25 within 30 days of giving notice as required by 57 Pa.C.S. §
- 26 314.1(g)(1), unless the department for good cause prohibits the
- 27 use of the technology for failure to satisfy the requirements of
- 28 57 Pa.C.S. § 314.1 or determines that use of the technology
- 29 should be delayed pending an evaluation of the technology. This
- 30 section shall expire upon the adoption of regulations by the
- 31 department as required by 57 Pa.C.S. § 314.1(h)(2).
- 32 Section 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
