13 (d) Data.--

14 (1) Where it is determined by the coroner to be  
15 necessary to fulfill the statutory responsibilities of the  
16 coroner's office, the Department of Health shall provide  
17 electronic access to appropriate databases to the coroner  
18 for:

19 (i) Information reportable under the act of April  
20 23, 1956 (1955 P.L.1510, No.500), known as the Disease  
21 Prevention and Control Law of 1955, for deaths known or  
22 suspected to be due to a contagious disease constituting  
23 a public health emergency or pandemic.

24 (ii) Death certificates.

25 (2) The Department of Health may not charge a fee to the  
26 coroner for electronic access to data under this subsection  
27 and may not require the coroner to obtain a subpoena.

28 (3) The coroner shall follow all applicable Federal and  
29 State laws, regulations and confidentiality standards for  
30 data obtained under this subsection.
