

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 47

1 Amend Resolution, page 2, by inserting between lines 12 and

3 WHEREAS, Technological developments have enabled numerous  
4 competitive providers to enter the voice and broadband  
5 marketplace using multiple technologies, and most consumers have  
6 the ability to choose and purchase services from regulated and  
7 unregulated providers; and

8 WHEREAS, Today, traditional landline voice providers have  
9 less than 12% of the total voice subscriptions in this  
10 Commonwealth but are still required to maintain a network that  
11 can provide voice service to every customer in the provider's  
12 service territory; and

13 WHEREAS, While regulation of traditional landline voice  
14 services has remained relatively unchanged in this Commonwealth  
15 despite these dramatic changes in the industry, the technologies  
16 that consumers use to communicate have fundamentally altered the  
17 marketplace and continue to do so; and

18 WHEREAS, Modernization of regulations and statutes has  
19 already been undertaken in many states as consumers have  
20 transitioned from landline voice services to products offered by  
21 unregulated or lightly regulated entities; and

22 WHEREAS, The provision of broadband service across this  
23 Commonwealth must recognize that because of technological and  
24 competitive developments, the appropriate method to support and  
25 incentivize further expansion of broadband should be technology  
26 and policy neutral; and

12 Amend Resolution, page 6, line 26, by striking out the

13 semicolon after "Commonwealth" and inserting

14 including:

15 (i) modernizing telecommunications policies,  
16 regulations and statutes regardless of technology and the  
17 elimination of outdated and unnecessary regulations; and

18 (ii) eliminating barriers to the expansion of  
19 broadband availability;
