1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 12, by striking out "cargo" and

2 inserting

3 ballot

4 Amend Bill, page 1, line 18, by striking out "Cargo" and

5 inserting

6 Ballot

7 Amend Bill, page 1, line 19, by striking out "use a cargo

8 securement procedure" and inserting

9 adopt ballot security procedures

10 Amend Bill, page 1, line 23, by striking out "with" and

11 inserting

12 during any point in which the ballots are not at a voting
13 precinct or county board of elections, unless in custody of the
14 United States Postal Service. The transportation container shall
15 possess

16 Amend Bill, page 2, line 3, by inserting after "lading"

17 for ballots outside of a voting precinct or county board of
18 elections

19 Amend Bill, page 2, line 4, by striking out "cargo securement
20 procedures" and inserting

21 ballot security procedure

22 Amend Bill, page 2, line 11, by inserting after "ballots"

23 until the ballots are precanvassed or canvassed

24 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 15 through 18, by striking out "The
25 bill of lading shall remain with the ballots cast in" in line 15

26 and all of lines 16 through 18 and inserting

1 Any bills of lading that are not sealed in a transportation
2 or storage container shall be kept in accordance with the
3 county's ballot security procedures and shall be available for
4 inspection by a poll watcher.

5 Amend Bill, page 2, line 19, by inserting after "broken,"
6 it should be stored with the bill of lading and

7 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 25 and 26, by striking out "ballot
8 storage location is monitored by staff, the staff" and inserting
9 transportation container containing ballots is moved,
10 documentation shall be kept with the container, including the
11 name of the individual who handled or had custody of the
12 transportation container. The individual

13 Amend Bill, page 2, line 27, by inserting after "election."

14 Storage and maintenance of chain of custody of documents
15 shall be prescribed in the county's ballot security procedures.

16 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 28 through 30, by striking out
17 "numbered" in line 28, all of line 29 and "the election," in
18 line 30 and inserting

19 number of transportation and storage containers containing
20 ballots in a given election,

21 Amend Bill, page 2, line 30, by striking out "counted" and
22 inserting

23 precanvassed, canvassed
