

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 71

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 1, by striking out "an amendment"

2 and inserting

3 separate and distinct amendments

4 Amend Bill, page 1, line 2, by striking out " in taxation and
5 finance," and inserting

6 further providing for compensation and

7 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 6 through 8, by striking out all of
8 said lines and inserting

9 Section 1. The following separate and distinct amendments to
10 the Constitution of Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with
11 Article XI:

12 (1) That section 8 of Article II be amended to read:

13 § 8. Compensation.

14 (a) The members of the General Assembly shall receive such
15 salary and mileage for regular and special sessions as shall be
16 fixed by law, and no other compensation whatever, whether for
17 service upon committee or otherwise. No member of either House
18 shall during the term for which he may have been elected,
19 receive any increase of salary, or mileage, under any law passed
20 during such term.

21 (b) No member of the General Assembly may receive any salary
22 or compensation from any source in addition to the salary and
23 compensation under subsection (a).

24 (2) That Article VIII be amended by adding a section to
25 read:

27 through 13; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and
28 inserting

29 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
30 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the
31 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to

1 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
2 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
3 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
4 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
5 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments.

6 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these
7 proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the
8 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
9 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
10 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
11 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
12 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
13 these proposed constitutional amendments. The Secretary of the
14 Commonwealth shall:

15 (1) Submit the proposed constitutional amendments under
16 section 1(1) of this resolution to the qualified electors of
17 this Commonwealth as a single ballot question at the first
18 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
19 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of
20 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which
21 occurs at least three months after the proposed
22 constitutional amendments are passed by the General Assembly.

23 (2) Submit the proposed constitutional amendments under
24 section 1(2) of this resolution to the qualified electors of
25 this Commonwealth as separate ballot questions at the first
26 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
27 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of
28 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which
29 occurs at least three months after the proposed
30 constitutional amendments are passed by the General Assembly.
