9 Section 1. Section 1505(b) of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania  
10 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:  
11 § 1505. Death of registrant.

13 (b) Other sources.--A commission shall utilize information  
14 obtained from the department through the Electronic Registration  
15 Information Center. A commission may also utilize information  
16 obtained from State-licensed funeral home records, county  
17 coroner records, death certificates provided at the commission's  
18 office, published newspaper obituaries, letters testamentary or  
19 letters of administration issued by the office of the registrar  
20 of wills to cancel and remove the registration of an elector,  
21 provided that such removals are uniform, nondiscriminatory and  
22 in compliance with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-  
23 110, 42 U.S.C. § 1973 et seq.). The commission shall promptly  
24 update information contained in its registration records.
